Optimist Skate Park Facility Rules

The Waterloo Park District is proud of this facility and hopes that you use it safely. It is your skate park and as such, **YOU have a responsibility to care for it.**

The following rules have been established to promote the safe and enjoyable use of the facility. It is the responsibility of all users to know, understand and abide by these rules. The Park District and Optimists encourage family use of the facility. Please conduct yourself accordingly.

Skate at Your Own Risk and Skill Level!

Helmets, kneepads, elbow & wrist pads & proper shoes are required at all times while using the facility.

The following are NOT tolerated/permitted in the skate park area;

- * Alcoholic beverages
- * Food or beverages
- * Drugs
- * Smoking and/or tobacco products
- * Glass containers of any type
- * Pets
- * Fighting
- * Profanity
- * Headphones
- * Loud music
- * Vandalism/graffiti/tagging

Spectators are required to observe from outside the fence.

This facility is unsupervised and self-policed!

Inspect the premises before use.....snow, ice, wet surface, litter & debris etc. may affect skating/riding conditions.

- Reckless and destructive behavior jeopardizes the safety of others.
- Do not use ramps and runs until they are clear of other skaters.
- Do not skate/ride against traffic.
- Be respectful of other skaters/riders.
- Be a positive role model and mentor younger skaters/riders.
- The use or placement of any unauthorized equipment or obstacles is prohibited.
- Graffiti, tagging or other forms of defacing Park District property is strictly prohibited and will cause the facility to close.
- Waxing of skate park surfaces is prohibited.
- Keep the facility trash free.
- Children must be at least 10 years old to use the facility and must be supervised by an adult if participant is under the age of 16 years old.
- **Wavier/release of liability are required of ALL patrons of skate park; parent/guardian signatures required for minors (under 18 years of age).**
- **Waiver forms are available on website www.waterlooparkdistrict.org, www.waterlooiloptimist.org, at City Hall & Police Dept. (Mon-Fri 8:00 AM —4:00 PM).**
- **Fines of \$75-\$500 will be incurred for each infraction of rules by City Ordinance.**

All organized events require prior written approval from the Waterloo Park District.

Be courteous of other people using the facility, all other park patrons & residents in the area.

Please report any damage, hazardous conditions, concerns, comments or suggestions to the Waterloo Park District at 618-939-0438 & leave a message 24/7.

The Waterloo Park District reserves the right to close the facility at any time for any reason and to change these rules at any time. The District also reserves the right to ask persons to leave the facility and restrict entry to the facility if rules are not followed and unsafe behavior is observed.

This facility is open from 9:00AM to 9:00PM. The “NO TREASPASSING” rule will be enforced after the facility is closed.
