- Park Hours: 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM (November March)
 - 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM (April October)
- This facility is unsupervised.
- This facility is for skating and biking only. If you are not skating, biking, or playing hockey, you must remain outside the fence.
- The Waterloo Park District does not assume any liability for injury to participants or spectators involved in activities connected with skateboarding or biking.
- Children under 10 must be supervised by an adult.
- Helmets are required at all times, and elbow pads, knee pads, wrist pads and proper shoes are strongly recommended while using this facility.
- Do not skate when it is wet rain, snow, and ice may affect skating/riding conditions.
- Know your limits and abilities, YOU are responsible for YOUR safety.
- Skate/Ride safely.
- Be respectful of other skaters/riders, especially beginners. Remember you are on video surveillance at all times.
- No moving elements or bringing in elements.
- No waxing of skate park surfaces.
- No smoking, alcohol or drug use.
- No vandalism, graffiti, tagging or stickers.
- No glass containers of any kind are allowed.
- Keep the area trash free. Place all litter and trash in the trash receptacles.
- No pets are allowed.
- No loud music.
- No profanity or fighting.
- **REMINDER:** This skate park is self-policing. Please be respectful of all skaters and remember you are on video surveillance at all times.
- Be courteous of other people using this facility, all other park patrons, and residents in the area.
- All organized events require prior written approval from the Waterloo Park District.

The Waterloo Park District reserves the right to close the facility at any time for any reason as well as to change these rules. The Waterloo Park District also reserves the right to ask persons to leave the skate park and restrict entry to the skate park if rules are not followed and unsafe behavior is observed.
