The Waterloo Park District welcomes you and your group to our parks. Please read the rules and regulations for pavilion use contained in this contract. **In order to keep our parks beautiful and clean, all visitors are expected to abide by all park rules and regulations and to respect the park property and other patrons to the park.** The operation, maintenance, and improvements to our parks are made possible with the pavilion fees, bequests, donations, and contributions from generous civic-minded citizens, organizations, and taxes paid by residents in the Waterloo Park District and City of Waterloo. **Please bring this form with you to the park the day of rental.**

Rules and Regulations

- Park hours: Dusk to Dawn (Hours are enforced)
- The person making the reservation is liable for damages to the park and for the conduct of the members of his/her/their group. Fines for damages, non-compliance, and unreasonable use may occur.
- The Park District is not responsible for accidents. Users of the park accept the park as is and use the park at their own risk. **If 9-1-1 is called, notify the Waterloo Park District of the occurrence at 618-939-7967.**
- If you plan to barbeque, you must bring your own charcoal. **Portable grills are prohibited.**
- All tables are to remain under the pavilions.
- There is a limit of two roasters per pavilion.
- Do not overload electric outlets. If you overload the outlets, you will trip the breaker and you may have no electricity. Four-way connectors are prohibited.
- All large inflatables, water slides, and faucet hookups of any kind are prohibited.
- Driving in the park is limited to paved roads and at a **speed not to exceed 10 mph** or as posted. Barricades and traffic control devices are not to be removed.
- Parking is only allowed in areas as directed by park personnel or signs. **No parking on grass at any time.**
- Carrying and discharging of firearms or other noisemakers are prohibited. **Absolutely no fireworks!**
- Pets are NOT
- allowed in the PICNIC or PLAYGROUND areas and must be kept on a leash at ALL TIMES.
- Playground equipment is for children only. Adults are prohibited from using all playground equipment.
- The Konarcik Park Tot Lot is for the use of preschool children only
- The handicap swing at William Zimmer Park is to be used only by those children with special needs.
- Fishing is permitted during daylight hours only. **A valid fishing license is required.** There is a limit of one pole and line to each fisherperson. Daily limit as posted: 1 bass (15 inches plus), 5 bass (14 inches or less), and 10 crappie (a minimum of 10 inches each). All undersized fish are to be returned to the water immediately with the least injury to the fish possible. The use of minnows as bait is prohibited. The capture of aquatic stock for personal gain is prohibited.
- The use of non-motorized boats, kayaks, or canoes is allowed.
- Wading, swimming, or ice skating is prohibited in **ALL** waters of **ALL** parks.
